#### Minchenden Update

I am happy to tell you all that planning approval has now been given for the new site in Southgate. This means that the project will now be going out to tender. The official line from the Local Authority is that the Minchenden site should be open in time for the start of the school year in September 2018. We will keep you up to date on developments.

## **Staffing Update**

Following recent interviews we made two new appointments to our staff. Our new recruits will be joining us on a permanent basis after Easter. We have also appointed Tashan Charles as a trainee teacher under the School Direct programme from September. Tashan has worked as a Teaching Assistant at Durants for 6 years and is now ready to train to become a teacher at our school.

#### **Growing Numbers**

Due to the increasing population in Enfield, we are experiencing a growing demand for places at Durants. It is possible we may need to create another class at Durants as well as an additional class at the Winchmore Additional Resourced Provision (ARP). We are working with the Local Authority to ensure that we can accommodate this demand without compromising what we already offer to those students already at Durants.

#### **Parent Governor Election**

Directly after Half Term, we will be holding an election for a new parent governor. Alicia Meniru has been a parent governor at Durants for many years. She has been an incredible governor who has really supported the governing body to move the school forward. She will be a big loss to the governors but we would like to thank her for all the amazing work she has done on behalf of all the parents with children at Durants. 

## **Transition At Durants**

Just a few words to let you all know what developments have taken place with Transition in the Upper Department this year.

We will be having about 8 students leaving in July 2016 and most of those will be attending the Centre of Excellence for Learners with Learning Difficulties at Barnet + Southgate College.

With this in mind, I have managed to secure a room at the College for 6/7 sessions and plan to travel by public transport from Durants school (121) directly to Southgate, making use of their facilities and room at the college for an hour's lesson and then return to Durants by bus in time for afternoon buses. This will enable the students to familiarise themselves with their new environment.

For students transitioning to other placements, we are planning to put similar programmes in place as resources (both human and physical) are available.

I would also like to draw your attention to the school's website that has further information regarding transition in the Upper department, as well as specific Transition information. Also, if your young person is coming up to 18 within the next six months, please make sure you have visited alternative after school provisions/respite that might be suitable and continue when they have eventually left Durants.

I will also keep you updated with any forthcoming Open days at Barnet + Southgate College or other transition events.

Equally, some routes were running smoothly and the relevant escorts and drivers received praise from parents. The survey has been discussed with, and given to, the Head of Transport, as well as the Head of the Joint Service for Disabled Children.
