Minos

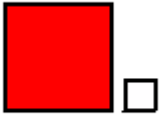


Crete

King Minos lived on an island called Crete.

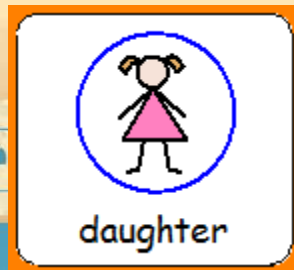

King Minos also had a beautiful daughter called Princess Ariadne.

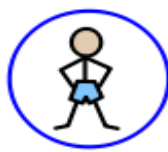


King Minos also has a big and powerful navy.

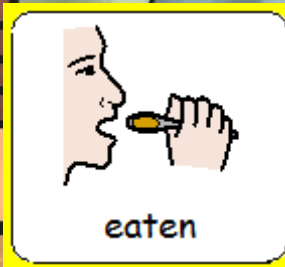
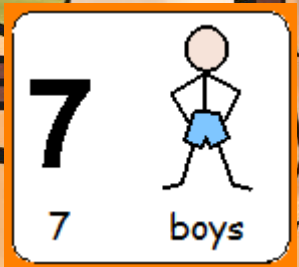
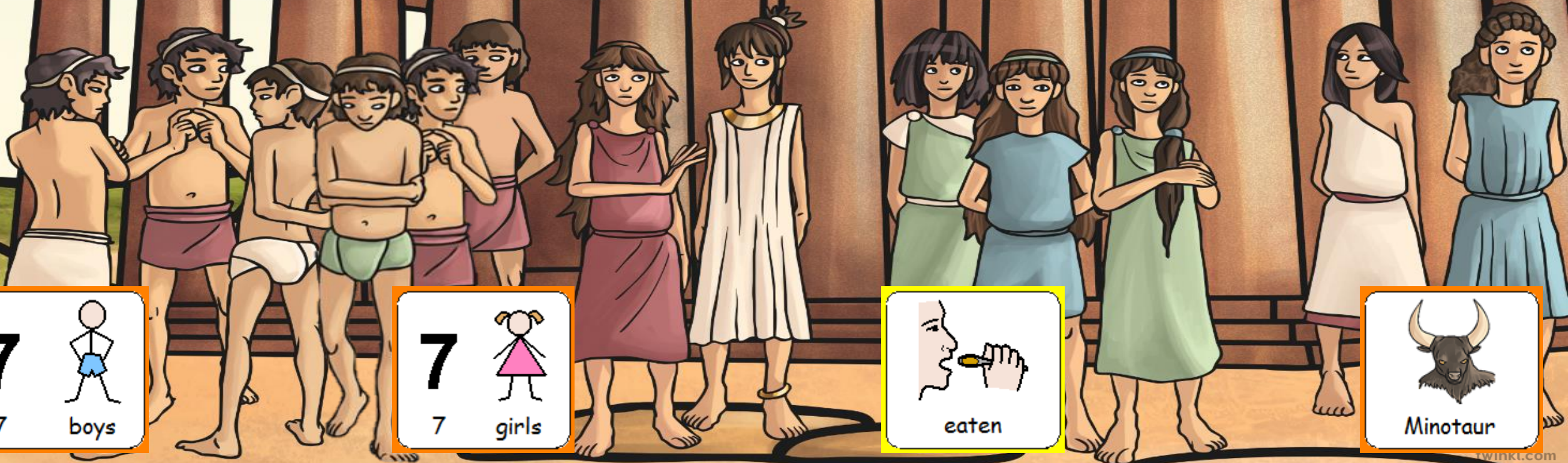


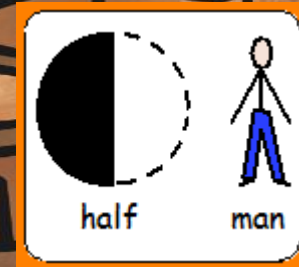
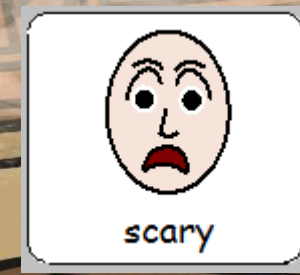
Minos

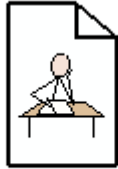

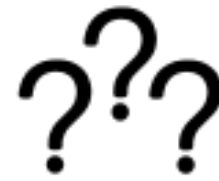
